Associate Professor Anthony Holley, AM

Associate Professor Anthony Holley is a Senior Staff Intensivist at the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital and an Associate Professor at the University of Queensland. A former ANZICS President, he served on its Board and Executive for over a decade and was a Senior Examiner for the College of Intensive Care Medicine. He has co-authored 58 peer-reviewed papers, 12 book chapters, and contributed to national guidelines on patient blood management and COVID-19.



In the Australian Defence Force, CDRE Holley is Principal Consultant Trauma to the Surgeon General, advising on ADF trauma care strategy. He has deployed on multiple operations, including Afghanistan, Iraq, and disaster relief efforts. A recipient of two Navy Commendations, he was awarded the Navy's Matthew Davey Award for his work on deep-frozen blood products. In 2024, he was appointed a Member of the Order of Australia for his contributions to Emergency and Intensive Care Medicine.

Dr. Stuart Paterson is an Australian-trained consultant anaesthetist based in Tasmania. He has a special interest in clinical education, research, and simulation within the peri-operative environment.
